For this event, you must be on an active APA team (8 Ball, 9 Ball or Masters). You must have a skill level based on at least 10 scores. 10 scores must have been earned in the last 2 years. Open 9 ball players who have never played 8 ball or have not played on an Open 8 ball team in over a year will have their skill levels determined by the tournament director. Master players that have never played on an Open 8 ball team or have not played Open 8 ball in over a year will play as a skill level 7. No timeouts or coaching allowed. 100% of the entry fees will be paid out top approximately 25% of the field in each bracket. Number of entries in each skill level will determine the how the brackets we have. Optimum would be a bracket for each skill level. The more entries we receive, the more brackets we can create. Format will be modified, single elimination.

# Tournament Of The Pool Gods

Play starts 7 pm, Saturday, April 18, 2020

Open To Active APA Members Only!

Blind draw scotch doubles, Fast 8, Race to 2, Modified single elimination, APA Rules

Entry fee \$5 (includes \$2 green fee)

100% of the entry fees will be paid out to approximately 25% of the field. Rack is 4 stripes, 4 solids, racked like 9 ball with the 8 ball in the middle Rules: Lag for the break, Players alternate shots starting with the first break. Rotation continues throughout the entire race. If your partner pockets the 8 ball to win the game, you will break the next rack. There will be no timeouts or coaching. During the course of the race, play will be stopped by the Master Of The Universe at least once. While play is stopped, the Master Of The Universe will roll a 12 sided die to determine what fate the Pool Gods will bestow upon you.

Dice Roll Fate:

1. Current shot must be taken "monkey on your back style). Shooter must shoot with their partner as the bridge
2. Current shooter must take the next shot using the butt of their cue
3. Lose your turn. Pool God will give ball in hand to the non shooting team
4. Current shooter must take next shot blindfolded.
5. Pool God will randomly pick any ball on the table and place it in the pocket. Exception: If the last ball on the table is the 8 ball, there is no penalty and play continues.
6. Pool God will place a marker next to the pocket that the 8 ball must legally be pocketed to win the current game. Marker is removed at the end of the current game.
7. Pool God will pick up the cue ball and place it anywhere on the playing surface. Current shooter must shoot the cue ball from that position.
8. Current shooter must pick someone from the opposite sex, who is not their partner, to shoot the next shot. Shot must be completed within one minute or you will forfeit your turn. (Replacement player can be anyone in the room)
9. Switch Shooters. If you are the current shooter, you will switch places with your partner. New rotation will continue from that point on for the rest of the race. Your partner shoots, then you shoot, etc.
10. Current Shooter must shoot next shot left handed
11. Pool God will place a marker next to a pocket. That pocket is no longer available. Any ball that goes into that pocket is not legally pocketed and will be immediately spotted and reenters the game. If this is the only ball pocketed for the shooter, it is the end of their turn. Marker is removed at the end of the current game.
12. Current shooter must shoot the next shot one handed.

# APA NW 8 Ball Invitational

## Basic Rules

Each event is open to all APA members who have a skill level based on a minimum of 10 scores. The 10 scores must be in one format or the other, 8 ball or 9 ball, and must have been earned in the last 2 years. 9 Ball players who do not have an 8 ball skill level may have their skill level adjusted. Players must be in good standing with the league. Each player's skill level will be reviewed prior to the tournament and monitored throughout the tournament. If we are not able to retrieve a player's true scores from their league operator prior to the start of the tournament, that player will not be allowed to play. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** The handicap review committee, made up of the league operators present, will be the sole authority in determining whether or not a player is properly rated and has the authority to raise skill levels during the events if they feel that their play during the tournament warrants such action.

Entry forms and fees must be postmarked by no later than, April 6, 2020. Special cash drawing will be held for those who get their entries postmarked by March 27, 2020, Cancellations will be accepted through April 9 with a full refund. Any cancellations after April 9 and prior to April 14 will receive 50% refund of entry fees. No shows will not be entitled to any refund of entry fees.

**Dress Code:** You are representing the APA and should dress accordingly. No ripped or torn clothing, short-shorts or tank tops will be allowed. Those displaying excessive cleavage, bare mid-sections or see through clothing will be required to cover up. This goes for males and females alike. Females may wear sleeveless, collared shirts that are in good taste. Males must wear shirts with sleeves. No item deemed lewd or offensive by the tournament committee will be allowed in the tournament area.

**Sportsmanship:** Remember, good sportsmanship is the key to having a good time. Any person or team displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will be severely reprimanded up to and including disqualification from the tournament with forfeiture of entry fees and any monies won. Local penalties may be assessed if warranted.

There will be official referees assigned during each round of competition. The decision of the referee is FINAL!

**Payouts:** The top 64 teams (based on a minimum of 128 teams) will receive payouts in the 3 person team event. Approximately 25% of the field in each of the scotch doubles and each bracket of singles will receive payouts. 100% of the entry fees minus greens fees will be paid out in each event. The number of entries in each event will determine all payouts. Payouts will be in the form of a voucher made out to the team captain and must be cashed at the main casino cashier by midnight, April 19, 2020 or they will become void. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to pick up the voucher, get it cashed and distribute the funds to their teammates.

No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the tournament room.

No outside food or drink will be allowed in the tournament room during the times when the food service and bar are open inside the tournament room

The pool tables are rented. Please no drinks at the table. Any damage done to the tables caused by reckless behavior will be the responsibility of the person involved (who will also be automatically banned from the tournament) There is no smoking or electronic cigarettes allowed in the tournament room. You may smoke on the casino floor in designated areas.

Absolutely no illegal drugs or weapons will be allowed in the tournament room. Anyone believed to be under the influence of drugs or overly intoxicated will be banned from the tournament area and/or the casino.

The tournament director and the tournament committee will back up any decision of the Chinook Winds staff regarding a player in our tournament. If you get yourself 86'd from the casino and/or the tournament room for any reason, don't come crying to us. Local penalties may be assessed as well if warranted.

Mini tournaments will be conducted throughout the event by Biggelbach's Billiards. Practice tables will be available during the main events when possible. Tables will be closed during practice and mini tournaments. **YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PRACTICE ON UNLOCKED TABLES!** Please do not sign up for a mini tournament until your team has finished play for the day. No player will be allowed to sign up for more than one mini tournament at a time. If you should sign up for more than one tournament and your match is called in another, you will forfeit your match and entry fee. Entry into the mini tournaments will be in cash and paid out in cash. You need not be enrolled in the main tournament events to participate in the mini tournaments.

Tables are \$1 per rack. There is a token machine in the tournament room to purchase tokens. Left over tokens may be redeemed with the table techs prior to leaving the tournament. The table techs will be on duty at all times during the tournament. The tokens have no value except for use in the pool tables. Do not use them for tips, for purchase of any items or try to gamble with them.

Only those persons authorized by the tournament director will be allowed to solicit the players or spectators to purchase merchandise of any kind. If you have an item you would like to sell, you must first get the approval of the tournament director and pay a fee to do so.

We welcome guests and spectators, however, they are subject to the same code of conduct as are the players.

You may sign up for Singles, Pool Gods and Weekender Scotch while at the tournament, prior to posted deadlines, however pre-registration is advised for guaranteed entry.
